you that are playing in the 2005 Yoot
Shoot, Lakewood Shores has offered us
something really special. All guests
will have the opportunity to play at
Indianwood Country Club in Lake
Orion, Mi.. The site of the 1994
Women's U.S. Open, Indianwood is
steeped with tradition. Originally built
in 1925, the club was the playground for
the Detroit elite in the early days. Host
to the 1928 Western Association Open
& numerous Michigan PGA events in
those early days, brought the club
notoriety throughout the United States.
Now you too can "lace'em up" and
walk the hallowed ground of this private
club, which normally would require you
to be a member. As a member of the
2005 Yoot Shoot, you can be member
for a day! The \$110 rate includes 18
holes of golf w/cart on either the old or
new course, lunch on the course and 2
drink tickets. Play is limited to
TUESDAYS only, and there must be a
minimum of 4 players. Tee times for
