Your Last Call – Or They'll be Returned for All

For anyone wanting to add a practice round on Thursday, a FREE round on Crystal Mountains Betsie Valley Course is available if you stay at Crystal Mountain for Thursday evening! (\$15 cart fee only required) This is to be set-up by those individuals directly and IS NOT part of the package. Thursday night lodging is available at the rate of \$89.00* / room (no matter how many people stay in them). Thursday rooms & Thursday tee times are to be set-up directly with Crystal Mountain. (Phone number listed at left) If you plan on golfing this "pre-round", be sure to book your tee time also when calling to reserve your room. (DO NOT book your Friday/Saturday rooms or you will be responsible for them – that will be done as part of your package) Every effort will be made by Crystal Mountain to get you into the same room you will have for the entire weekend.

We are currently holding a block of rooms for anyone wanting Thursday evening lodging. After August 17th, all held rooms will be returned for sale to general public and availability cannot be guaranteed.
