Run for Da Hills!

Fresh off another great year of the Golf Channels hit series The Big Break X: Michigan, Boyne Highlands courses were featured showing the world what Northern Michigan golf is all about. Many of the competitions took place on The Arthur Hills course, which we will play as part of the 2010 Yoot Shoot on Saturday Sept. 25th. A spectacular layout, reminiscent of the towering pines in the Sand Hill area of North Carolina, the course winds its way through the Boyne Highlands Valley before climbing to the mountain summit of hole #13 (shown below) providing a grand view of the valley below. Tempting you to wail a drive of a lifetime, be careful as unforeseen trouble lurks left and right. Anything left on this hole, tumbles all the way into the #12 rough or fairway with virtually no shot but to hit back into the #13 fairway. Anything right and...well... you can tell from the picture below...you better have your chainsaw club in your bag. This course will provide a dramatic setting for our final round of the 2010 Yoot Shoot.

YOOT FACTS!
